# Notes of Meeting 04.07.2023

#### **Matters Arising**

Sheena reported that one more person had completed the patient's survey making 34 people in total. It was decided to close this survey and put out a revised one next year. Sheena had contacted the 7 people interested in becoming involved with either the PRG (Patients Reference Group) or the PPG (Patients Participation Group). Of these only 3 had replied to her email. It was decided to invite these 3 people to a PPG meeting.

## **Report from Parkside Practice**

Leaza reported that it had been a quiet summer.

Doctor Thilo said that unfortunately there were long waits for patients being referred for investigation at the hospital. Cancer patients used to have an appointment in 2 weeks now the guidelines are 28 days.

The hospitals are replying to doctors referrals saying that a certain investigation is not appropriate and the Doctor then has to make a case for the investigation. It was thought this was to enable hospitals to manage their workloads better.

The feedback about reception has been positive.

A new Care Coordinator starts next week. She will advise on Diabetic and Cancer care amongst other things. She will be doing some training with Macmillan Nurses. She will also visit house bound patients.

Another care coordinator will be employed later.

One nurse will be away for a few weeks for a hip replacement. We all wished her well. 2 Doctors are returning from maternity leave.

The Care Quality Commission asks for monthly assessments. If there is a problem Leaza has to attend a 4 hour consultation and submit evidence that all is well. If this is satisfactory the monthly assessments can continue.

#### Lift at Woodley Surgery
