It was asked if when test results or x-rays come back from the hospital if the Doctor could add a note so the receptionist could tell the patient. The patient then would not have to have a telephone consultation with a doctor if all is well. Blood test results are already coded in this way so it was thought something similar may be able to be done so long as it didn't take up too much of the doctors time.

It was noted that the patient has to be proactive to follow up and to ascertain whether the results are available rather than expect them to be contacted by the surgery.
